

Introduction:






The event featured a detailed explanation of the importance of the occasion by the **Principal** of ASM CSIT, Dr. Lalit Kanore. Dr. Kanore likely emphasized the Constitution's role as the supreme law of the land, detailing how it shapes the governance of the nation and safeguards the rights of its citizens. He would have highlighted the monumental efforts of the Constituent Assembly and its Drafting Committee, led by Dr. B. R. Ambedkar, in creating a document that is both aspirational and comprehensive. This detailed explanation provided an educational component, encouraging attendees to appreciate the historical context and the foresight of the Constitution's architects.

Furthermore, Dr. Kanore's address would have focused on the learning from the occasion, particularly the foundational values of Sovereignty, Socialism, Secularism, Democratic Republic, Justice, Liberty, Equality, and Fraternity as outlined in the Preamble. The takeaway for the students and faculty was the active responsibility of every citizen to uphold these ideals. He would have stressed that learning from the Constitution means not only knowing one's rights but also understanding one's duties and ensuring the spirit of fraternity and national unity is maintained in all walks of life. The event's purpose was to instill a sense of constitutional morality and civic duty among the participants.

The event concluded with a formal expression of gratitude. The Vote of Thanks was delivered by Asst. Prof. Sonia Roy. The collective effort of the faculty, coordinated by the Event Coordinator and overseen by the Vice Principals and the Principal, ensured that the college successfully marked this important occasion, reinforcing the constitutional values among attendees.

- 5 Students who benefited from the event served as a practical reinforcement of knowledge related to governance and civics, complementary to academic studies.













