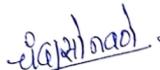

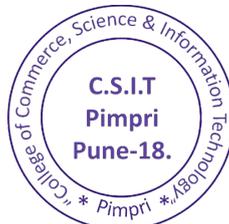

Competition 5: Photography

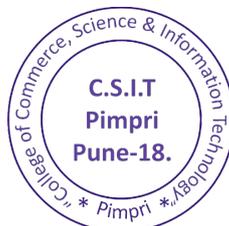

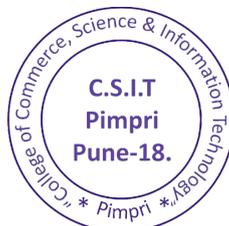
Introduction:

Our college fielded participants in four distinct events, each designed to test a unique set of skills. The following is a detailed breakdown of each competition and our students' involvement.

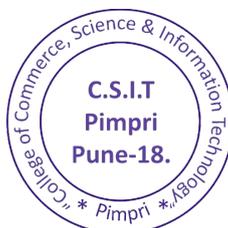
Competition : PowerPoint Presentation

Participants were challenged to create a rangoli based on a specific social theme, requiring them to translate an abstract concept into a visually compelling piece of art.

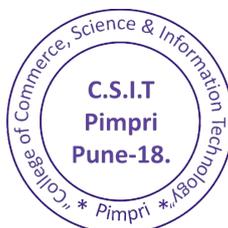

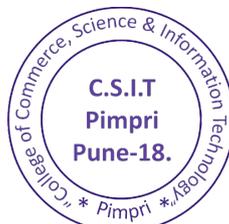

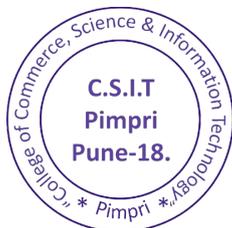
