We invite all faculty, staff, and students to participate in this inspiring event to pay tribute to Dr. Kalam's remarkable contributions to science, education, and nation-building.







Introduction:



Objectives:


- 1 To honor the life and legacy of Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam, focusing on his contributions to science, education, and nation-building.
