Objectives:


- 1 Proper techniques and precautions while **driving vehicles**

Detailed Report:

The **Road Safety Awareness Program** was conducted on **9th August 2024** in the **Main Auditorium** of ASM CSIT College. The session began with a welcome speech by the Student, emphasizing the increasing need for awareness about road safety, especially among young students.


A guest speaker from Damini Pathak, an expert in traffic management and road safety from the local traffic police department, was invited to deliver a speech. The speaker covered various key topics, including:

- **The importance of traffic rules and regulations** in daily commuting
- **Common causes of road accidents** and how to prevent them
- Demonstrations on **correct usage of helmets and seatbelts**
- Videos showcasing **real-life accident cases** caused due to negligence
- An interactive Q&A session to address students' queries




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The session also included a brief **demonstration of basic vehicle safety checks** and encouraged students to spread road safety messages in their communities. A feedback session at the end revealed that students found the program informative, engaging, and helpful in changing their perspectives on responsible driving. Pamphlets and booklets on traffic rules were distributed to all participants.




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Outcomes:
