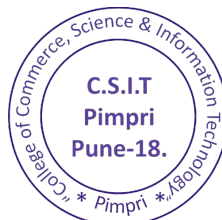

Introduction:

As part of the implementation of the **National Education Policy (NEP) - 2020**, ASM's College of Commerce, Science and Information Technology, Pimpri, organized a **Campus Tour Initiative** under the **School Connect 2.0** program. The event, held from **1st January to 15th January 2025**, was conducted in collaboration with **Savitribai Phule Pune University** and **ASM's Junior College, Pimpri**.

This initiative aimed to introduce students of grades 9, 10, and 12 and their parents to the core elements of NEP-2020. Through a well-planned series of sessions, activities, and guided tours, participants gained valuable insights into educational reforms, interdisciplinary learning, and the holistic approach of the new education policy.

Objectives:

- 1 To create awareness about the National Education Policy (NEP) - 2020 among school students and their parents.
- 2 To showcase the academic infrastructure, resources, and student-centric facilities available at the college
- 3 To motivate students to pursue higher education through NEP-aligned pathways
- 4 To provide interactive sessions and practical demonstrations emphasizing skill development and interdisciplinary education

The program was launched with an **inaugural session** each day, where visiting students and faculty from the following institutions were welcomed:

Each visiting batch was introduced to ASM's institutional mission and vision, followed by an **NEP-2020 awareness session** supported by multimedia presentations and expert explanations. During the **campus tour**, students visited modern classrooms, computer labs, the digital library, seminar halls, sports arenas, and incubation centers. The tour enabled visitors to connect NEP principles with real-world academic resources.

Interactive sessions offered Q&A opportunities where students could engage with faculty, alumni, and NEP facilitators. Discussions focused on subject flexibility, multidisciplinary education, skill development, and career pathways.

The **exhibitions** displayed innovative student research, departmental achievements, and NEP-aligned academic projects. Visiting students also enjoyed **cultural performances** by ASM students centered on unity, education, and progress.

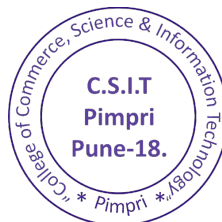
