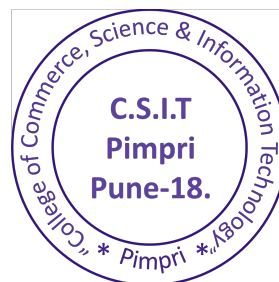

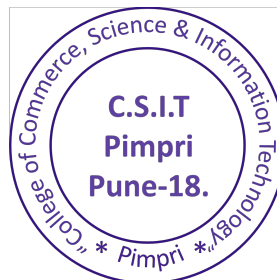

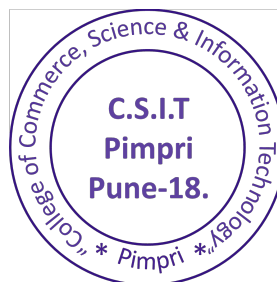

Detailed Report:

On February 20, 2025, ASM's CSIT College and IPS joined forces to commemorate Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj Jayanti with a deeply respectful and enthusiastic celebration. This annual event honored the birth anniversary of the legendary Maratha warrior-king, whose visionary leadership, military genius, and progressive governance shaped the course of Indian history. The event was distinguished by the presence of esteemed dignitaries, including Dr. V.P. Pawar, Dr. Sudhakar Bokephode, Dr. V. Barbate, Dr. Lalit Kanore, Dr.C.D.Sonawane, and Asst. Prof. Sarita Goyal, whose participation underscored the significance of the occasion.

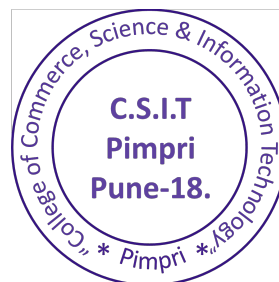
The day's proceedings commenced with traditional ceremonies, beginning with Pratima Pujan (idol worship) to pay homage to the revered figure. Critically, Jadhav drew parallels between these historical attributes and the challenges and opportunities faced by today's youth, emphasizing the continuing relevance of Shivaji Maharaja's leadership principles in the 21st century. He inspired the audience to consider how these principles could guide their own paths and contribute to building a better future.

Subsequent speakers expanded upon the themes introduced by Jadhav, providing deeper insights into specific facets of Shivaji Maharaja's life and accomplishments. Dr. Lalit Kanore offered a unique historical and strategic perspective, focusing on the specific strategies employed by Shivaji Maharaj in the development of the Chinchwad Devasthan, a significant religious and cultural site. His presentation shed light on the planning and vision behind this important undertaking.

Dr. V.P. Pawar shifted the focus to Shivaji Maharaja's personal qualities, offering a more intimate glimpse into the character of this great leader. He further enriched the historical narrative by acknowledging and discussing the substantial contributions of Sambhaji Maharaj, Shivaji Maharaja's son, whose own life and sacrifices played a crucial role in the Maratha narrative. Dr. Pawar's recommendation of the book "Chhava" served as an invitation for students to explore the lives of both Shivaji Maharaj and Sambhaji Maharaj in greater depth.

The celebration was further enlivened by a series of captivating cultural performances that showcased the rich traditions of Maharashtra. Ms. Geetanjali, an MBA student, delivered a stirring rendition of a Powada, a traditional Marathi ballad that narrates tales of valor and heroism.
