

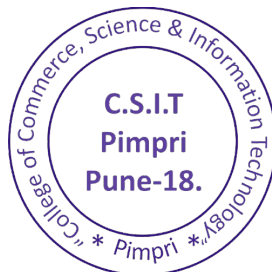

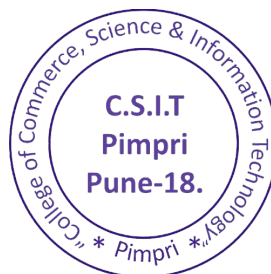

Introduction:

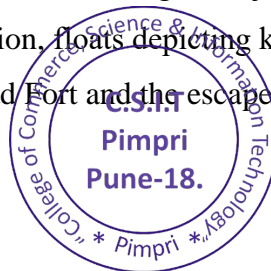
Shiv Jayanti Walking Rally Report – February 19, 2025 On February 19, 2025, Maharashtra celebrated the 395th birth anniversary of Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj with grand ‘Jai Shivaji, Jai Bharat’ padyatras (walking rallies) held across all districts. The rallies, organized to honor the Maratha warrior king’s legacy, witnessed massive participation from citizens, students, historians, and political leaders.

Detailed Report:

In Pune, the main padyatra commenced from Shaniwarwada and concluded at Fergusson College, covering several historic sites associated with Shivaji Maharaj. The procession was led by Chief Minister Devendra Fadnavis, accompanied by prominent dignitaries, local officials, and cultural organizations. An estimated 20,000 people participated in the rally, chanting slogans praising the valor and leadership of Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj. Many participants were seen wearing traditional Maharashtrian attire, carrying saffron flags, and showcasing historical re-enactments of Shivaji’s battles. Cultural and Traditional Celebrations The padyatra featured various cultural performances including Lezim, Dhol-Tasha, and Malkhamb demonstrations, which are integral parts of Maharashtra’s folk heritage. Local artists performed Powadas (ballads narrating Shivaji’s heroic deeds), adding to the patriotic fervor of the occasion. In addition, floats depicting key events from Shivaji Maharaj’s life, such as the coronation at Raigad Fort and the escape from Agra, were displayed along the



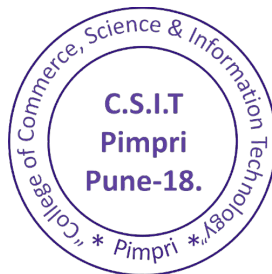
rally route. The event highlighted the warrior king's vision, military strategies, and contributions to Swarajya (self-rule).

Traffic and Security Arrangements

Due to the grand scale of the rally, the Pune Police had implemented strict traffic restrictions on major roads, including Laxmi Road, J.M. Road, and Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj Road. Barricades were placed at key intersections, and alternate routes were suggested for commuters. The security arrangements included a large deployment of police personnel, drones for aerial monitoring, and medical teams to handle emergencies.

Participation Across Maharashtra -Similar padyatras were held in Mumbai, Nashik, Nagpur, Kolhapur, and Aurangabad, drawing thousands of devotees and historians. In Mumbai, the main procession started from Shivaji Park, Dadar, and concluded at Gateway of India, where a special tribute was paid to the great Maratha ruler. In Nagpur, the padyatras began at Raje Raghuji Bhosale Memorial in Sakkardara Chowk, with traditional performances attracting a large audience. Cities like Kolhapur and Satara, closely linked to Shivaji Maharaj's history, also hosted grand celebrations.

Conclusion :-The Shiv Jayanti padyatras of 2025 served as a reminder of the enduring legacy of Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj. The event fostered unity, pride, and a sense of historical consciousness among the people of Maharashtra. The massive participation and well-organized cultural programs made this year's celebrations truly memorable. The success of the rally reaffirmed the deep respect and admiration that people continue to hold for Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj, ensuring that his ideals and contributions remain alive in the hearts of future

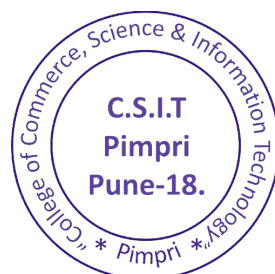

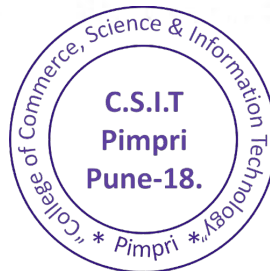
